

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 5 of 1975

TO MAKE supplementary appropriation for the service of the Joint Administration for the year ending 31st day of December 1972.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 5 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and section 5 of Joint Regulation No. 10 of 1957 with the approval of the governments of Her Britannic Majesty and the French Republic.

Appropriation. 1. The sums set forth in the schedule hereto amounting to one hundred and seven million seven hundred and ninety-one thousand New Hebrides francs or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars at the current rate of exchange having been expended, for the services of the Joint Administration therein respectively specified, beyond the amounts granted for these services under the provisions of the 1972 Appropriation Joint Regulation are hereby declared to have been duly and necessarily paid and expended in respect of the financial year ended 31st day of December 1972, and shall be charged upon the general revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration in addition to the amounts mentioned for those services in the said Regulation.

Citation and commencement 2. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Supplementary Appropriation (1972) Regulation No. 5 of 1975 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
