BE IT ENACTED by the President and Parliament as follows:-

AMENDMENT

The Representative Assembly (Members' Expenses and Allowances) 1 . Regulation, 1900 as amended, is further amended by substituting the following for subsection (1) of section 0:-

"Subject to the provisions of this subsection, members of Parliament (other than the Speaker and Ministers) shall be paid a subsistence allowance at the rate of VT 3.000 for each day of one session when Parliament or a committee thereof sits.

are the transfer

when a memoer arrives in Vila a day before the commencement of the session, he shall be pard an additional allowance of VT 3.000 for that day.

when rarliament is in session the allowance shall also be paid for Sacurdays, Sundays and public holidays notwithstanding that rarliament may stand aujourned on those Gays.

A deduction of VT 3.000 shall be made from the allowance payable co a member under this subsection, for each day a member is absent from a siccing of Parliament or a committee thereof. And when such absence is on a friday, a deduction of VT 3.000 shall also be made for each of the Saturday and the Sunday if an allowance is otherwise payaule. And where such absence is on a day before a public noliuay or nolidays a deduction of VT 3.000 small be made for each such day or days, as the case may be, if an allowance is otherwise payable."

COMMENCEMENT

This act shall be deemed to have come into force on the loth day 2. of november 1985.
