To further amend the Representative Assembly (Members' Expenses and Allowances) Regulation, 1980.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Parliament as follows:-

AMENDMENT

1. The Representative Assembly (members' Expenses and Allowances) Regulation, 1980 as amended, is further amended by substituting the following for subsection (1) of section 6:-

"Subject to the provisions of this subsection, members of Parliament (other than the Speaker and Ministers) shall be paid a subsistence allowance at the rate of VT 3.000 for each day of the session when Parliament or a committee thereof sits.

When a member arrives in Vila a day before the commencement of the session, he shall be paid an additional allowance of VT 3.000 for that day.

When Parliament is in session the allowance shall also be paid for Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays notwithstanding that Parliament may stand adjourned on those days.

A deduction of VT 3.000 shall be made from the allowance payable to a member under this subsection, for each day a member is absent from a sitting of Parliament or a committee thereof. And when such absence is on a Friday, a deduction of VT 3.000 shall also be made for each of the Saturday and the Sunday if an allowance is otherwise payable. And where such absence is on a day before a public holiday or holidays a deduction of VT 3.000 shall be made for each such day or days, as the case may be, if an allowance is otherwise payable."

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th day of November 1985.
