Instrument of Appointment of Minister Order No. 54 of 2009

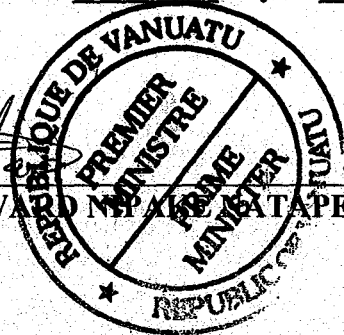
