CHAPTER 20

THE PRISONERS (RELEASE ON LICENCE)
ORDER NO. 15 OF 1992

An Order to provide for the release of the prisoner named hereunder.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Prisons (Administration) Act (CAP.20), I, SETHY J. REGENVANU, Acting Prime Minister and Minister responsible for Prisons, HEREBY MAKE the following Order :-

RELEASE OF PRISONER ON LICENCE

1. The Prisoner IMELDA CHAMBERS, who is currently being held in custody in the Vila Prison in the Republic of Vanuatu shall be set free and released from prison on 15th August, 1992 SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS set out in section 2 and 3 of this Order.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

2. The following terms and conditions shall apply :-
 - (a) The prisoner shall leave the Republic of Vanuatu within twenty four hours of leaving the Vila Prison.
 - (b) In the event that the prisoner does not leave the Republic of Vanuatu within the specified period, the prisoner shall automatically be recalled and returned to prison.

PROCEDURES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF CONDITIONS OF RELEASE, RECALL TO PRISONS, ETC.

3. In the case where the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 2 apply, the following procedures shall apply :
 - (a) Where the Minister is satisfied that the prisoner has violated the terms and conditions set out in section 2 the Minister shall issue a Notice in writing directing that the prisoner be returned to custody forthwith;
 - (b) A Notice issued by the Minister shall be served on the prisoner directing her to return to prison at such time and on such day as specified on the Notice;

- (c) The prisoner when returned to prison in accordance with this section shall be obliged to serve the unexpired term of her sentence which she would have had to serve if she had not been released in accordance with this order;
- (d) The prisoner when returned to prison in accordance with this section is not entitled to have part of her unexpired term of sentence remitted.


**COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF PRISONS

- 4. The Commissioner of Police and Superintendent of Prisons shall take all lawful measures required or necessary to enforce every Direction or Notice issued by the Minister under this Order.

COMMENCEMENT

- 5. This Order shall come into force on the 15th day of August, 1992.
