THE OATH OF ALLEGIANCE (AMENDMENT)

**AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 1 TO CHAPTER 37**

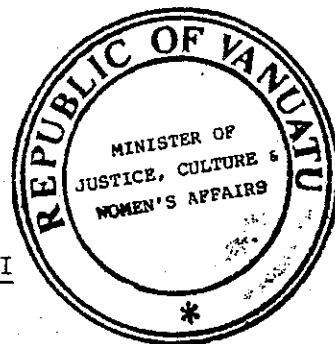
