COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ACT [CAP 85]

APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSION OF INQUIRY ORDER NO. 67 OF 2011

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1 and section 5 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act [CAP 85], I, the Honourable RALPH REGENVANU Minister of Justice and Community Services, make the following Order.

1 Definition

In this Order unless the contrary intention appears:

“Commission” means the Commission of Inquiry established under this Order;

“Minister” means the minister responsible for Justice and Community Services.

2 Appointment of Commissioner to the Commission

Captain Richard O' FERRALL is appointed as the Commissioner of the Commission.

3 Appointment of Assessors to the Commission

The following persons are appointed as the Assessors of the Commission:

Instrument of Appointment – Commissioner, Secretary and Assessor of the Commission of Inquiry of the Air Vanuatu Flight Operations during cyclone Atu

- (a) Willie KAPALU;
- (b) Ephraim KALSAKAU.

4 Appointment of Secretary to the Commission

Captain Peter FOGARTY is appointed as the Secretary of the Commission.

5 Remuneration of Commissioner, Assessors and Secretary

- (1) The Commissioner shall receive a remuneration of VT 300, 000.
- (2) The Secretary shall receive a remuneration of VT 150, 000.
- (3) The Assessors shall receive a remuneration of VT 100, 000.
- (4) The remunerations referred to in this clause shall be payable to the Commissioner, the Secretary and the Assessor after completion of the report referred to in paragraph 11 (b).

6 Use of Government Vehicle

The Commissioner, Secretary and the Assessors shall be entitled to the use of one Government vehicle between them for the purposes of the Inquiry.

7 Additional Costs

For the purposes of this inquiry the Vanuatu Government is to meet all reasonable costs. These costs shall include airfare, accommodation and per diem for the foreign-based Commissioner, and a per diem for the Secretary.

8 Terms of Reference

- (1) The Terms of Reference of the Commission are as set out in the Schedule of this Order.
- (2) The Terms of Reference of the Commission may be amended or varied by the Minister in consultation with the Commission.

9 Location of Inquiry

The Inquiry is to be made in Port Vila and at such other place or places as the Commission may determine.

10 Public or Private Inquiry

The Inquiry is to be held in Public except in circumstances as directed by the Commission.

11 Reports


The Commissioner must prepare the following reports:

- (a) a report of the proceedings and of the result of this Inquiry to the Minister not later than 28 days from the date of their appointments as Commissioners;
- (b) a report summarising his findings and his recommendations to be available to the Public not later than 14 days after submission of the report to the Minister. ^





6 Terms of reference

- (1) The Terms of Reference of the Commission are set out in the Schedule.
- (2) The Terms of reference of the Commission may be amended or varied by the Minister in consultation with the Commission.

7 Remuneration and cost

- (1) The members of the Commission are entitled to remuneration as follow:
 - (a) Commissioner – VT300,000;
 - (b) Secretary – VT150,000;
 - (c) Each Assessors – VT100,000.
- (2) Reasonable costs of the Commission to carry out their duties under this Order are to be covered by the Government.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Aim of the Commission

The aim of the Commission is to enquire into the extent to which designated authorities have complied with the recommendations of the Coroner and, where appropriate, to identify actions required to ensure full implementation of the said recommendations.

2. Objectives of the Commission

The objectives of the Commission are to:

- (a) inquire into the implementation status of all the recommendations of the Coroner's Report, to determine for each recommendation:
 - (i) whether the recommendation has been implemented by the designated authority / authorities;
 - (ii) if the recommendation has not been implemented, what factors have caused or contributed to the recommendation not being implemented ;
 - (iii) if the recommendation has been partially implemented, what stage in implementation has been reached and what factors have caused or contributed to the delay or prevention of implementing the recommendation ;
 - (iv) to what extent the factors that have delayed or prevented implementation stem from the wilful refusal of individuals and departments within the designated authority / authorities, and for these individuals and departments to be identified ;
- (b) identify the specific actions that need to be taken in order to restart and complete implementation of recommendation 1, so that those persons responsible for the death of John Bule are identified and prosecuted;
- (c) identify the specific actions that need to be taken in order to restart and complete implementation of recommendation 3, so that all available

evidence of alleged perjury by witnesses is assessed with a view to securing perjury convictions against those persons responsible;

- (d) identify the specific actions that need to be taken in order to complete implementation of the other recommendations;
- (e) generate a discussion paper as per recommendation 10 on how the Government can address the problem of a “dysfunctional group culture” within the VMF.

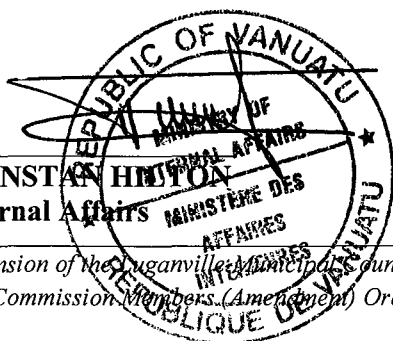

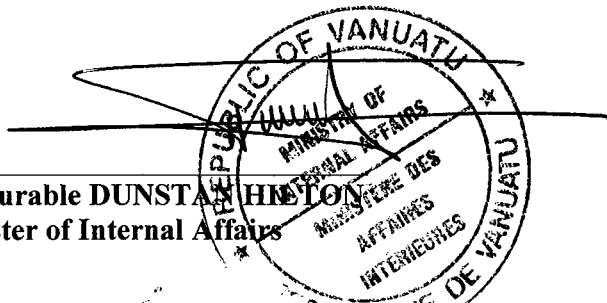


