### LIQUOR LICENSING ACT [CAP 52]

#### **Liquor Licensing (Prohibition of Sale) Order No. 22 of 2015**

To provide for the prohibition on the sale of liquor on certain premises throughout Efate.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [CAP 52], I, the Honourable JAMES BULE, Acting Minister of Internal Affairs, make the following Order.

#### **1 Sale of Liquor prohibited**

- (1) The sale of liquor by holders of:
- (a) an Urban General Off-Licence;
  - (b) a Rural Off-Licence,
  - (c) a Limited Off-Licence,
  - (d) a Club Licence,
  - (e) an Occasional Licence, or
  - (f) a Night Club License,

is prohibited from 12 o'clock midday on Friday 10 April 2015 to 12 o'clock midday on Wednesday 15 April 2015.

- (2) To avoid doubt, the prohibition applies to the sale of liquor from any nightclub, bottle shop, retail shop or kava bar in the island of Efate.


**2 Exception**

Despite clause 1, liquor may be sold during the period referred to in clause 1 within the normal hours of opening in restaurants, bars and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with food.

**3 Commencement**

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.

### NATIONAL DISASTER ACT [CAP 267]

#### Instrument of Direction to Government Agencies Order No. 23 of 2015

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 16(1) of the National Disaster Act [CAP 267], I, the Honourable JAMES BULE, Minister of Climate Change, Adaptation, Meteorology and Geo-Hazards, on the advice of the National Disaster Committee, make the following Order.

#### 1 Directions

The following directions are given to the following Government Agencies and the relevant senior Government officials from certain Government Agencies:

- (a) the Chairperson of the National Disaster Committee and Central Agencies are to identify and designate the vessels, aircrafts and vehicles to be chartered to transport relief supplies to the areas affected by cyclone PAM;
- (b) the Director Generals of the Government Ministries and the Directors of the Government Departments are to release their non-essential staff to assist in the distribution of relief supplies to areas affected by cyclone PAM.

#### 2 Commencement

This Order is taken to have commenced on 20 March 2015.
