

THE CHINESE CONTRACT LABOUR CONTROL AMENDMENT
ORDINANCE, 1923.

Western Samoa.—No. 6, 1923.

AN ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Act, 1921.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Chinese Contract Labour Control Amendment Ordinance, 1923, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chinese Contract Labour Control Ordinance 1921 (hereinafter called the principal Ordinance).

2. (1) The Administrator may at any time and from time to time suspend and may also at any time and from time to time revive the operation of the principal Ordinance or of any part thereof in manner hereinafter provided.

(2) When the Administrator intends to suspend or revive the operation of the principal Ordinance or of any part thereof he shall cause to be published in the *Western Samoa Gazette* a notice that the operation of the principal Ordinance, or of such part will be suspended or revived, as the case may be, and of the date from which such suspension or revival shall operate.

(3) The publication of such notice in the *Western Samoa Gazette* shall be conclusive evidence of the suspension or revival, as the case may be, of the principal Ordinance, or of such part thereof as from the date stated in such notice.
