An Ordinance

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Act, 1921.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Importation of Fruit from Fiji Prohibition Amendment Ordinance, 1923.

Amendment of clause 3.

2. Clause 3 of "The Importation of Fruit from Fiji Prohibition Ordinance, 1920," is hereby amended by adding the following sub-clause thereto:

Administrator may permit importation from Fiji.

"(1). Provided that the Administrator may, by notice published in the Western Samoa Gazette, permit the importation of certain specified products from Fiji on such conditions and subject to such restrictions as he may think fit."
