An Ordinance

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The Land for Quarantine Purposes

2. In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by clause 261 of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920, and of all other powers and authorities thereunto enabling the piece of Native Land described in the schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purpose of a site for a Quarantine Station and for any other public purpose ancilliary thereto:
